

Terms and Conditions for additional hours at Lowther School Nursery

- From 15 January 2018 we will be offering extended hours in our Nursery dependant on availability of spaces.
- Current provision (Universal Offer) is 15 hour per week, either 5 mornings 8.30 to 11.30am or 5 afternoons 12.30 to 3.30pm
- Extended provision is an additional 15 hours per week
- Limited places will be offered to stay 8.30 to 3.30pm (7 hours) For parents who are entitled to 30 hours funding and taking up 5 days per week this will mean that there will be an additional 5 hours per week to pay at £7 per hour.
- Priority will be given to parents who are entitled to the 30 hour funding (15 hours Universal and 15 hours Extended) **and** i. are 'Looked After' children, ii. have exceptional family, social or medical need, iii. have siblings and iv. live nearest to the school. This criterion is in line with the school admission criteria.
- For parents who are not entitled to 30 hour funding there is an option to apply for the extended hours at £7 per hour dependant on availability. This could be for 1 or more days per week.
- Additionally, we are able to offer a small number of lunch time places from 11.30am to 12.30pm. Morning children have the option to stay an additional hour and afternoon children can arrive one hour earlier. This will be charged at £7 per hour or deducted from any 30 hour funding entitlement.
- All extended hours places will need to be booked and paid in advance each half term with Mrs Day in the school office.
- Children staying for the lunchtime session will need to be provided with a healthy packed lunch in line with school expectations.
