Dear Parents, Carers and Friends,

We made our first batch of playdough this week. Lots of children had a turn to measure the ingredients and help with the mixing. We then had lots of fun rolling and squishing it. I have added the recipe below. We played more name games using a ball outside in the garden to help us to learn each others names. We have been talking about things we like about ourselves and our new friends.



### Playdough Recipe

You can use any size of cup as long as you use the same one for the salt and flour.

- 1 cup of table salt,
- 2 cups of plain flour,
- 2 tablespoons of cream of tartar,
- 2 tablespoons of vegetable oil,
- 2 cups of hot water (from a kettle),

Food colouring and flavouring/fragrance are optional. Add all of the dry ingredients into a mixing bowl, add the oil to the hot water and if using the food colouring at this point. Mix ingredients well together until a dough is formed. Knead well until it is no longer sticky. An adult should do this until the dough is cooler. We sometimes add dried herbs, glitter or beads. You can substitute half of the flour for either chocolate
