Our Maths focus next week will be about shape. We will start with 2D shapes and move onto 3D shapes. We will be playing some guessing games, some descriptive games and looking at shapes in our environment.

We have been learning how to slide down the 'Firemans Pole' in the outside playground. The children are only allowed to use the pole when there is an adult standing beside it.
