- Phonics— Phase 2 phonemes. h, b, f, ff, l, ll and the HRS words 'his', and 'as'
- Pumpkin Soup— we have enjoyed learning about different seasons, leaf painting and painting pumpkin pictures
- Diwali— This week we learnt about the Hindu fest of Diwali. We read the story of Rama and Sita and made Diva lamps.
- Maths— . 1, 2, 3! Children will have opportunities to identify, subitise or count to find how many and make their own collections of 1, 2, and 3.
