This week we have been learning...

- Phonics— As we finished Phase 2 last week, this week we began our journey into Phase 3.
- Pumpkin Soup -we loved making pumpkin spiced cupcakes and changing parts of the story to make it our own!
- Remembrance Day—we were so impressed with the sensitivity and empathy the children showed as we talked about remembering the sacrifice soldiers made. The children will all have an opportunity to make their own poppy which we will plant in the sandpit and watch them as we take part in the silence.
