
## We love learning at Lowther

#### This week we have been learning...

English - In English this week we are looking at poetry—specifically poetry based on Fireworks! The children have been building these throughout the week using descriptive language and similes! I can't wait to read their finished pieces. Maths - In Maths we are continuing our work on 3 part addition and have started to look at different ways to bridge 10 by using our number bonds.

Science - Work continues on materials, looking at the difference between natural and man made objects.

History - This week we continued our topic on the First World War.- looking at methods of communication and discussing the significance of remembrance day.

DT - We have started our design and technology project—building our own fire engines! This week we focused on the design and identifying necessary features ( siren, hose, ladder etc.)

R.E. - Starting to unpick the Christian story of the nativity and understanding why this is celebrated.
