This week we have been learning:

- Maths (Number stories and subtraction skills).
- English (Lowther Fairies! - Wow! These exciting visitors have inspired diary writing and a focus on full stops and capital letters).
- Phonics (Phase 2, 3 and 5 review / Phase 4 consonant blends, e.g. spl, thr, etc.).
- Wider curriculum subjects (Music—Learning the names of unturned instruments, Science—What plants are around us now?, History—How has Barnes changed?, Art—Gradients and making dot pictures).

Next week we will be learning:
