This week we have been learning...

English - This week we have continued to look at Traditional Tales with a British/ European origin, with a focus on story settings. We have used our senses to explore what it might be like to be in a fairy tale forest and started to write some lovely setting descriptions.

Maths - In Maths we are solidifying our understanding of subtraction across 10 and using different methods (including partitioning and our number bonds to 10 and 20) to help us with mental maths calculations.

History - We have continued our topic on the First World War - looking further into the use of written coded messages.

DT - We continued to plan for our fire engine project this week - making some final design choices before the build!

R.E. - Continuing to study the Christian story of the nativity.

Music - Alongside their sessions with Mr Gradidge, we have been working on our Nativity numbers! I am sure you will have heard some renditions of the "Funky Camels" song at home!
