

#### Developing the Lowther School site further

I am delighted to announce that we have agreed a two year fundraising plan with the aim to

As you know, across the school, we have spare classrooms as we currently have fewer children than previously. We've already (with your help) started this work

Phase 1 – was the conversion of a KS2 classroom into our awesome Library.

**Phase 2** – was the conversion of the old Children's Centre spaces at the front of the school into a SEND learning room, a new family meeting room and a teacher's prep room.

These have all been highly successful new uses of space within the school.

We are blessed with even more opportunities to make the very most of all the wonderful space at Lowther. So we're ready to now launch Phase 3.

**Phase 3** is to now look at creating further specialist spaces across the school. Over the next few years we expect there to be 4 rooms available for conversion to specialist teaching spaces. What an exciting opportunity. The PTA's fundraising drive this year and next will be to raise enough money to complete Phase 3 of our plans.

In 2025 we would like to convert the first two rooms available. These are one of the classrooms upstairs in LKS2 and our current music resource base. Our target for this is £15,000
