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Pupil Premium/Disadvantaged Children Report April 2016 – 2017

The pupil premium is additional government funding for pupils who are eligible for free school meals (FSM) as of the January Census, or at any time in the previous six years, as well as pupils who have been looked after from local authority care.

In 2014/15 the amount was £1300 per pupil.

In 2015/16 the amount is £1,320 or £1,900 for looked -after children.

In 2016/17 the amount is £1,320 or £1,900 for looked -after children

The school uses the funds for additional provision to support attainment for the most vulnerable pupils. These include interventions and targeted support with teachers and teaching assistants, emotional and social support through family and additional psychologist hours, and financial support for trips, residentials, extra-curricular clubs, music tuition and swimming.

Our attainment and progress data for pupils in receipt of the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) compare favourably with national PPG performance, and are above in almost all areas.
