<b>Expenditure:</b> PE coach for one day per week <b>Rationale:</b> Sports intervention groups, specialist squad training and tournament preparation as well as attending/organising sporting fixtures	£5,500
<b>Expenditure:</b> Sports Lead and additional administration <b>Rationale:</b> Oversee curriculum including coverage and progression. Evaluation of different PE schemes. Audit equipment, organise fixtures, provide a range of sporting opportunities and co-ordinate health and activity week. Training and development of colleagues.	£975
<b>Expenditure:</b> Richmond Sports & Fitness Partnership SLA <b>Rationale:</b> To be part of the borough network and to ensure children have regularly high quality opportunities to compete at a good level.	£1,500
<b>Expenditure:</b> Borough Sports Competition <b>Rationale:</b> Provide children with an opportunity to compete in a high quality sports competition	£200
<b>Expenditure:</b> Swimming Coach (and lifeguarding) <b>Rationale:</b> Ensure children's confidence in the water and to take full advantage for all children of free swimming offer at local secondary school. Also extra opportunities to train for the Borough swimming gala.	£1800
<b>Expenditure:</b> Lunchtime 'fit for sport' provision 2 people <b>Rationale:</b> Promoting playing of sport at lunchtime, teaching rules, ensuring fair play, engaging 'inactive pupils'	£8,024
<b>Expenditure:</b> 100+ Medals for Sports Day <b>Rationale:</b> Creating a competitive but inclusive system for Sports	£200

<p><b>Expenditure:</b> Cover for teachers/sports coach/teaching assistants to coach at local tournaments and sports competitions e.g. netball, basketball, hockey.</p> <p><b>Rationale:</b> Ensure children are coached and supported by members of the staff team with the right knowledge and expertise</p>	£1000	
<p><b>Expenditure:</b> Rakat membership for mini bus transport</p> <p><b>Rationale:</b> Ensure efficient, safe and cost effective transportation to sports fixtures</p>	£50	
<p><b>Expenditure:</b> Track fees</p> <p><b>Rationale:</b> Providing children an opportunity to train and practice on a professional running track.</p>	£100	
<p><b>Expenditure:</b> New Dance Squad Kit</p> <p><b>Rationale:</b> Prompting more opportunities for children to represent Lowther in inter-school competitions / local school events in dance and performance sports e.g.gymnastics</p>	£100
